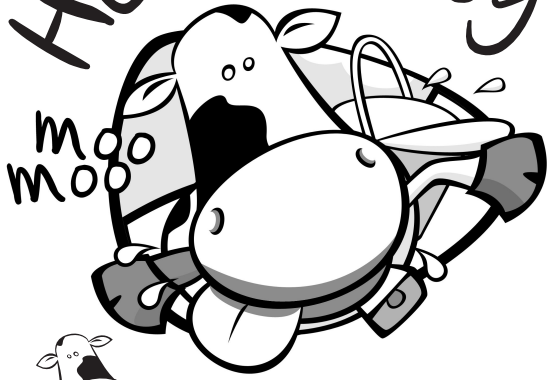


Here's Daisy



The Doddington Dairy Cow



Daisy is a Holstein-friesian dairy cow who lives at North Doddington Farm near Wooler in North Northumberland. The Maxwell family have farmed here for over 50 years. As well as Daisy and the other cows there are about 600 sheep and the farm also produces wheat, barley, maize and fodder beet. Most of this is fed to the cows and sheep, but some is sold to make bread and other food. Only milk from Daisy and her black and white buddies goes into luxury Doddington Dairy ice cream as well as several farmhouse cheeses such as Doddington, Berwick Edge and Cuddy's Cave, along with Admiral Collingwood and Baltic.
